SCSP (Schedule Caste Sub Plan) Scheme was implemented in ICAR-NIBSM Raipur. Nearly 70 numbers of selected healthy Sirohi Goats (50 female and 20 male) with average weight of 30 kgs were procured from MP Government Animal Breeding Centre, Kiratpur, Itarsi for distribution to SC farmers. Seed kits of improved variety of vegetables were procured from ICAR-IIHR, Bengaluru were distributed to the farmers of Asounda villages in ICAR-NIBSM, Raipur. Nearly 70 farmers belonging to Schedule Caste community of Asounda Villages, PO: Bangoli, District, Raipur-493 225, Chhattisgarh, were identified and benefited under this scheme. Farmers were distributed with one goat and one seed kits for upliftment of their livelihood options by increasing their income.

On this occasion two lectures on Goat Farming and their management and Vegetable Farming were also delivered for sharing technical knowhow to these beneficiaries' farmers.

This programme witnessed the presence of Sarpanch of Asaunda Village, Director, ICAR-NIBSM, Raipur, Joint Director (Research), Scientists and SCSP members of ICAR-NIBSM, Raipur.
